Europe – Ukraine (Lviv-Ternopil-Kropyvnytskyi-Kyiv-Lutsk-Poland).

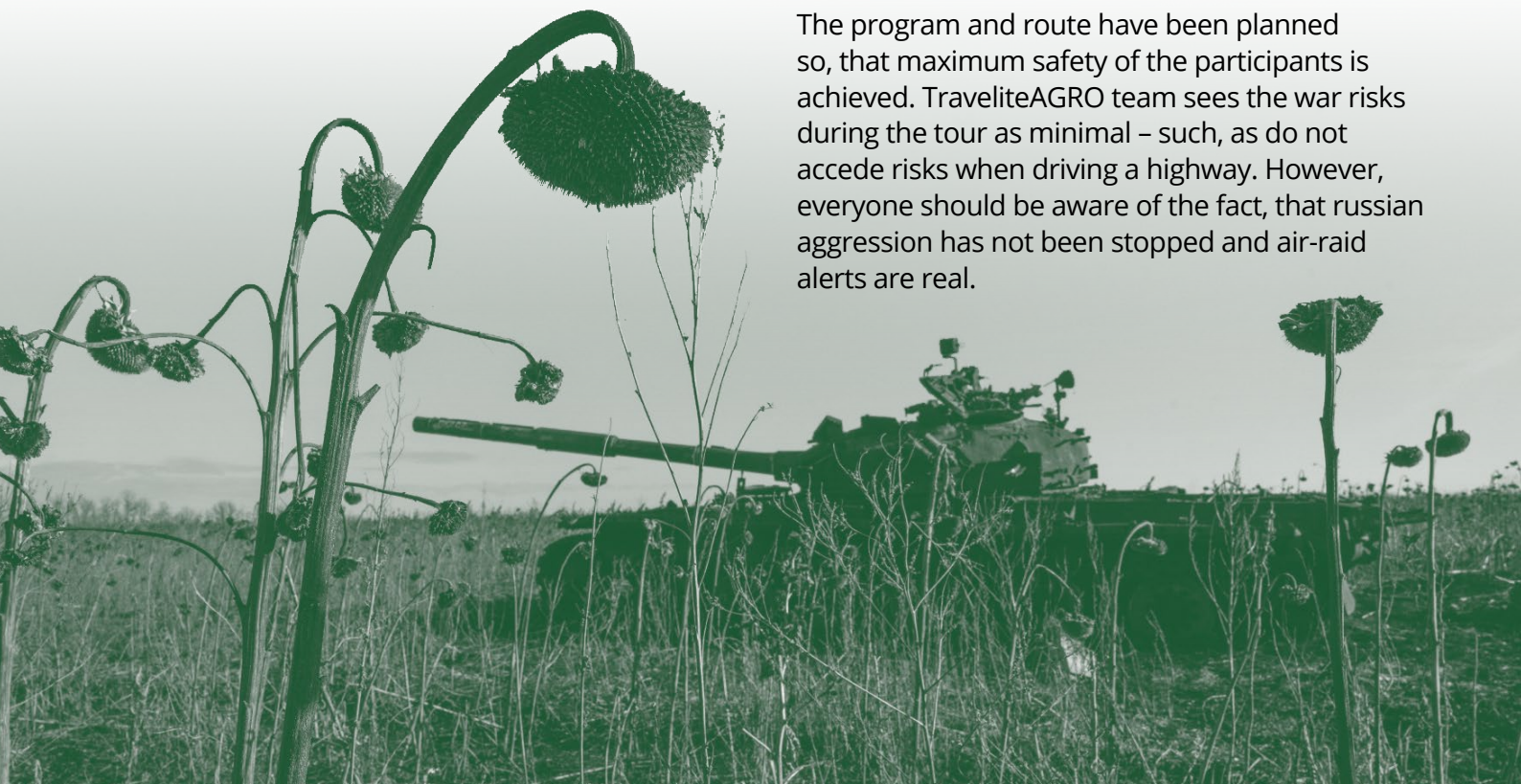

- **7:00–8:00 a.m.** Breakfast. Check out.
- **12:00 a.m.** Arrival to Ternopil. Dinner.
- **1:30 p.m. Visit to Private Enterprise «Agron»** – farm has 4 thousand ha of land, keeps 200 pigs, 30 geese, 50 sheep, 120 beehives, has a modern machine and tractor fleet, a service center, its own weather station, and a mini-bakery for the needs of the farm.
Currently, company grows winter and spring wheat, soybeans, rapeseed, corn, spring barley, and especially beets.
- Walk around the city. Dinner.
- Overnight at the hotel.



Day 6 12.02/11.07

- **8:00–9:00 a.m.** Breakfast.
- **10:00 a.m. Work with the «Technopol» company** – cultivates grain and technical crops, has a manufacturing plant that processes modern models of cultivators, hydraulic harrows, rotary harrows, etc.
- **2:00 p.m.** Lunch.
- **Work with «Technopol»** / city tour.
- Dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 7 13.02/12.07

- **9:00 a.m. Work with «Technopol».**
- **Visit to the plant where «Technopol»** also produces the applicator for the CULTAN technology.
- Dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

- **8:00. Visit to UKR-AGROTECHNOLOGY LTD** – farm cultivates about 6,000 ha, grows grain crops, legumes and seeds of oil crops, etc., has its own elevators.

- **8:00–8:30 p.m.** Arrival in Kyiv.
- Dinner. Check-in.

- **Visit to the farm «Amaranth Agro»** – grows grain and vegetable crops (wheat, corn and potato).
- Visiting 1-2 freed from occupation places in Kyiv.

- **Conference on Soil Cultivation (tillage) – TraveliteAGRO** / continuation of the cultural part of the tour around Kyiv.

- **Visit to the newest mill in Ukraine** – mill for processing rye grain with a processing capacity of 25 tons of grain per day (including additional grain cleaning and a milling department).
- Dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

- **9:00 a.m. Visit to the new land port (Lukiv city) of the «Vilia» company.**
- **2:00 p.m.** Lunch.
